BYLAW NO. 5-1999

A BYLAW RESPECTING ANIMAL CONTROL


The Council of the Town of Morse in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - a) "cattery" shall mean a place where cats are bred or looked after;
 - b) "domesticated" shall mean to accustom animals to live near the habitation near the habitation of humans; to tame;
 - c) "dovecote" shall mean a structure for housing pigeons;
 - d) "even-toed hoofed mammal" shall mean mammals having reduced number of functional toes and that rest their weight equally on the third and fourth toes of each foot. Examples are but not restricted to pigs, deer, cattle, antelope, llamas, sheep, goats;
 - e) "fur farm" shall mean a place where animals are bred for fur;
 - f) "kennel" shall mean a breeding or boarding establishment for dogs;
 - g) "odd-toed hoofed mammals" shall mean mammals having a reduced number of toes, each encased in a protective horny sheath, or hoof and the weight is carried mainly by the middle digit of each foot. Examples are but not restricted to: horses, asses, mules,
 - h) "poultry" shall mean domesticated birds kept for eggs or meat. Examples are but not restricted to: chickens, turkeys, ducks, geese, quail, quinea, fowl, pheasants, pigeons, ostrich;
 - i) "rodent" shall mean a mammal with strong incisors and no canine teeth. Examples are but not restricted to rabbit, chinchilla.
2. No person shall herd even-toed hoofed mammals, odd-toed hoofed mammals, poultry and rodents at any time within the limits of the municipality.
3. No person shall graze even-toed mammals, odd-toed hoofed mammals, poultry and rodents at anytime within the limits of the municipality.
4. No person shall keep even-toed mammals, odd-toed hoofed mammals, poultry and rodents at any time within the limits of the municipality.
5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
6. Bylaw No. 275 passed September 6, 1966 is hereby repealed.
